- ✓ Delivered as a flexible suite of interactive reports and data files in MS Excel format.

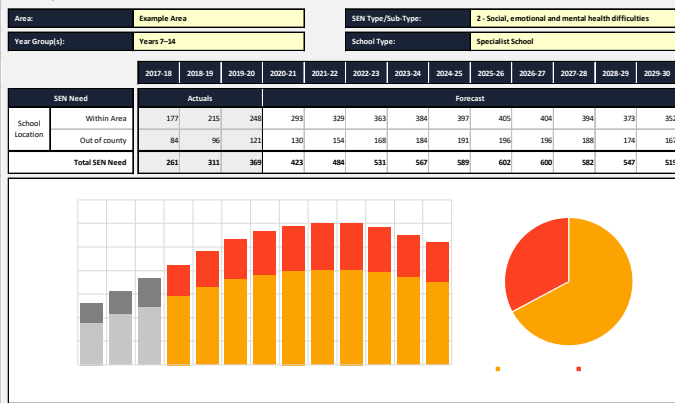
APPROACH
